Judging Criteria

Effectiveness - 10 points

- Does the video holistically address the challenge?
- Could the video be used by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE), the Organ Donation Advisory Committee (ODAC), or IU13 without substantial revisions?
- Is the video compelling enough to encourage people to become organ and tissue donors?

Benefits to the Community - 10 points

- Does the video address and meet the needs of the community, e.g. increase organ donation rates?
- Does the video include and address impacts to the community?
- Does the solution take into consideration dispelling myths and misconceptions by providing factual information?

Innovation - 10 points

- Does the video inspire organ donation?
- Does the video introduce an original or advanced concept to inspire organ donation?
- Does the video show promise as a catalyst for organ donation?

Presentation – 10 points

- Is the video presented in a captivating manner?
- Is the video presented with clarity and forethought?
- Did the video present all aspects of organ and tissue donation?

Project & Submission Guidelines

- Students must work together in teams (minimum of two up to a maximum of four individuals) to develop their innovative video that addresses the challenge of convincing peers and/or adults to become organ and tissue donors.
- All videos must be written, directed, and filmed by team members.
- The video is to be between 30 and 90 seconds in length.
- The submissions will be reviewed by select ODAC members, and the top three teams will be invited to present their video to a team of judges from the PDE.

The challenge is open to Pennsylvania high school freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors in public, private or charter schools. Note: PDE employees and their family members (siblings, children, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews) are ineligible to enter. Statewide judging events may be held in person or virtually.
